Code Of Conduct For Parents, Carers & Supporters

As a parent, carer and supporter of SWAN Junior Netball Club, try to work within the following guidelines:

Do not force an unwilling young person to participate in netball.

Remember young people are involved in netball for their enjoyment not yours.

Encourage your offspring to play to the rules and not to argue with umpires or other officials.

Teach your young person that honest effort is more important than victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.

Turn losing into winning by helping your young person work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.

Never ridicule or yell at a young person for making a mistake or losing a game.

Remember that young people learn best by example. Applaud good play by your team and by members of the opposition

Do not question the umpire's decisions or honesty. Remember he/she is only human with the same feelings as you, and like you, can sometimes make an honest error.

Recognise the importance and value of coaches. They give their time and resources to provide netball for your Netballer.

Read the rules of netball to understand better what you are watching and commenting on.
